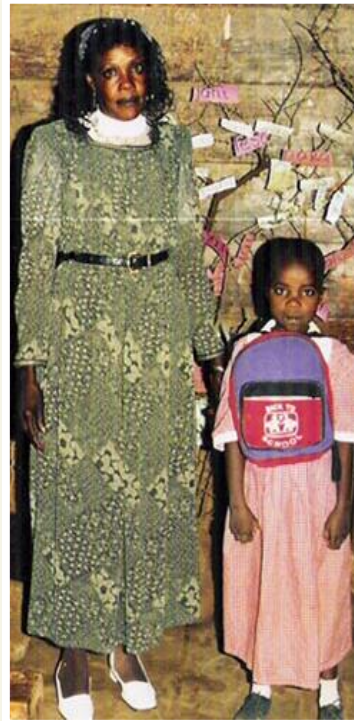

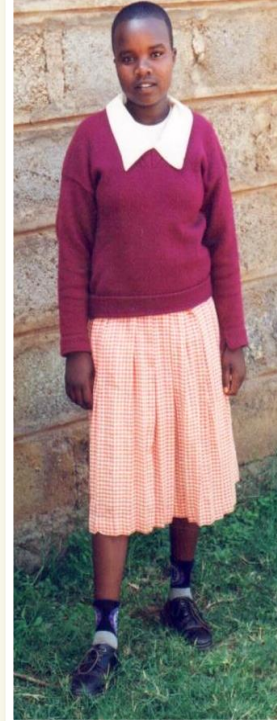

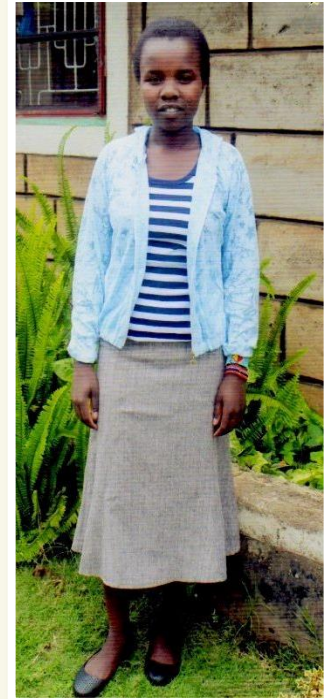
Ntidai, before she came to the home, living in abject poverty and with little hope for the future



Ntidai in her first day in school

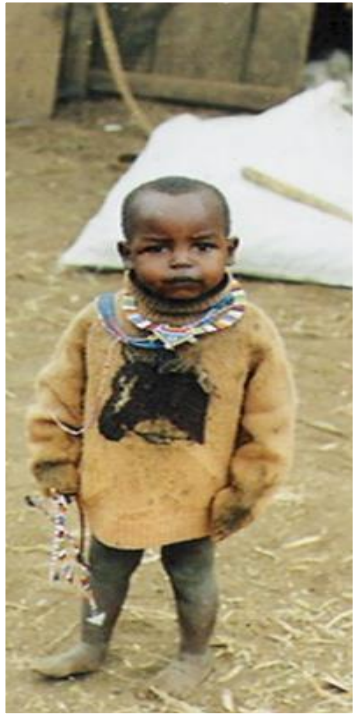


Ntidai in her final year in Primary school

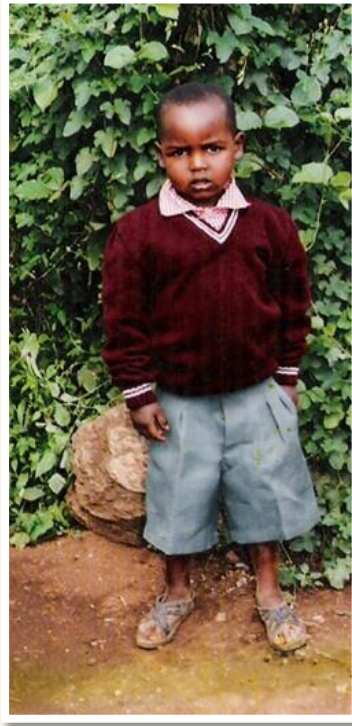


Ntidai in 2016, having cleared secondary school, her health was deteriorating during her secondary school, she now wants to train as a teacher

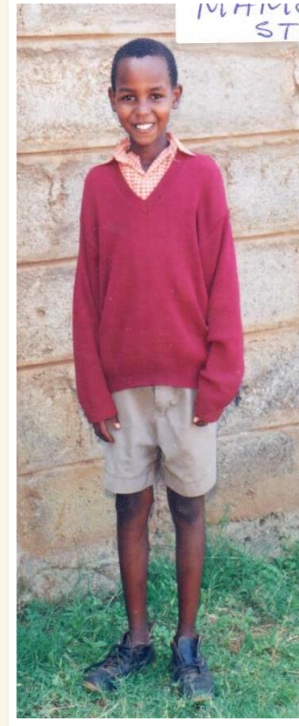

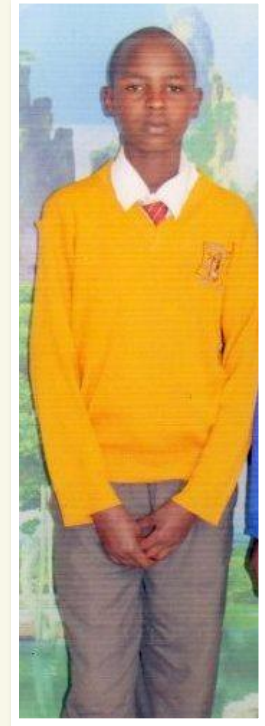

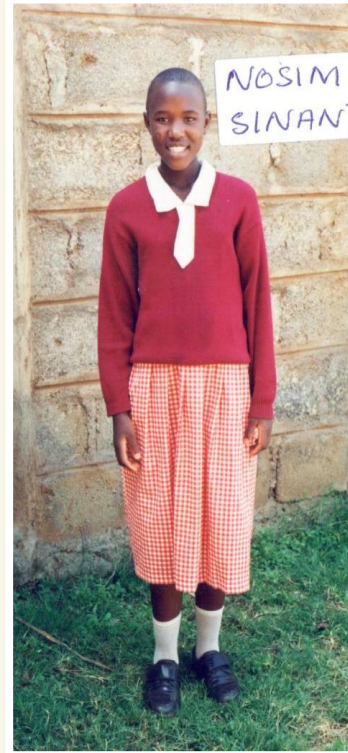

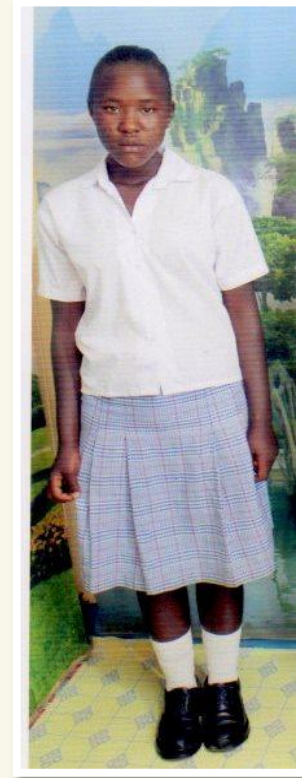
Nossim, before she came to the home

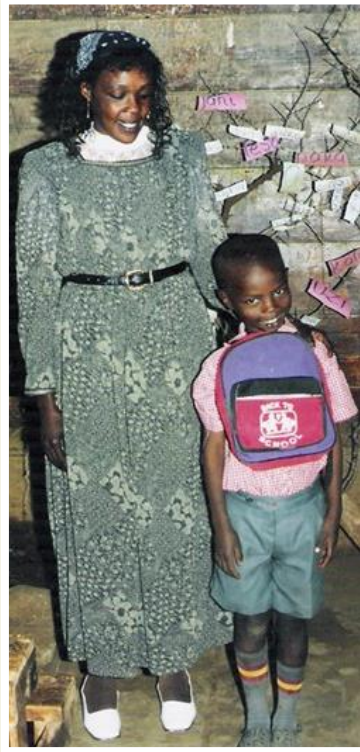

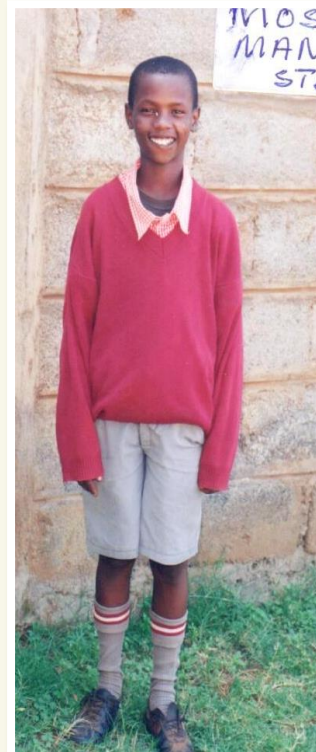

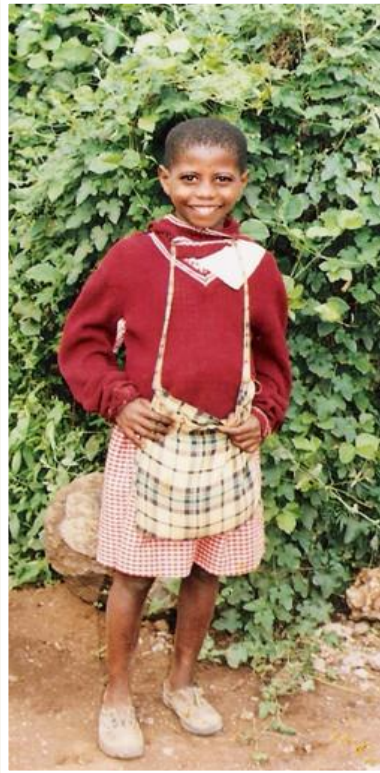

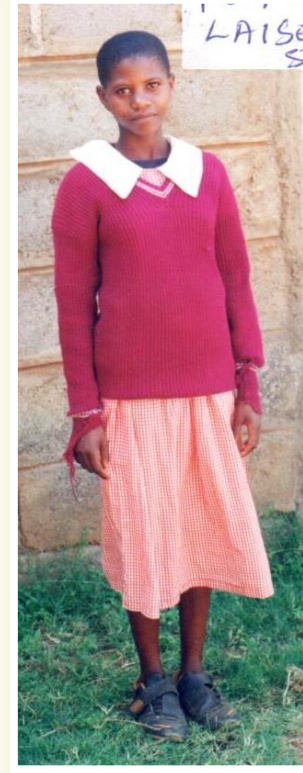
Toyie Lasier

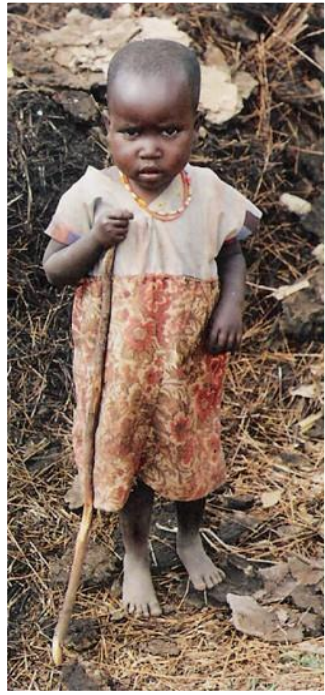


Toyie in mid primary school

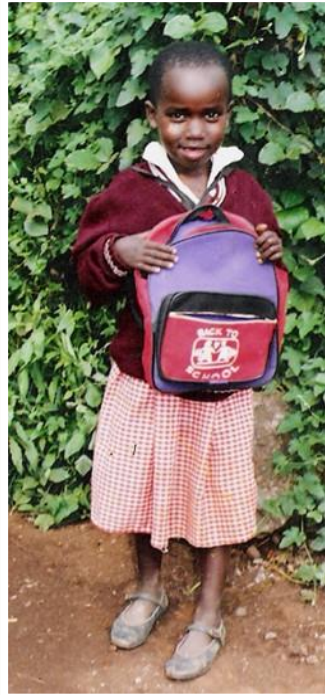

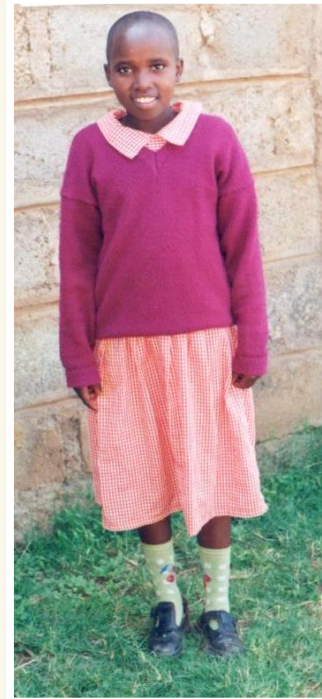

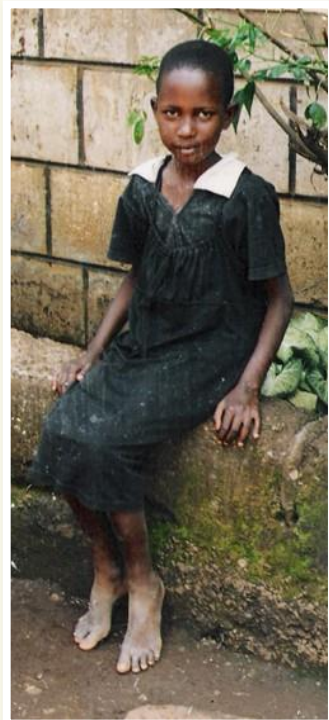

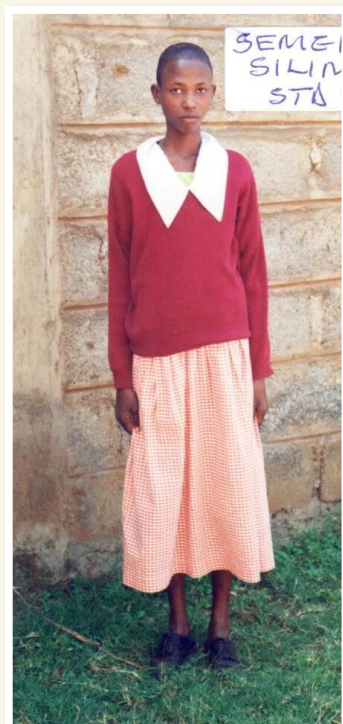

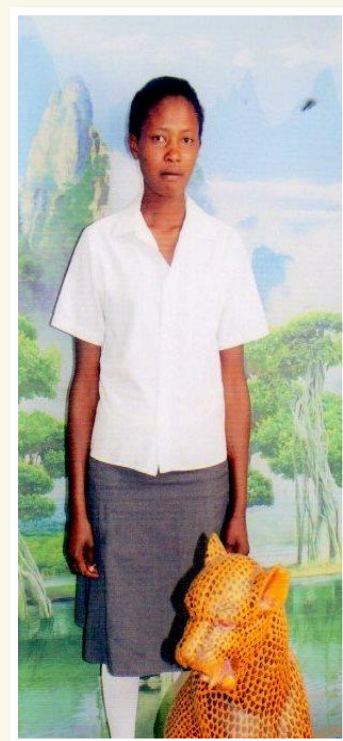

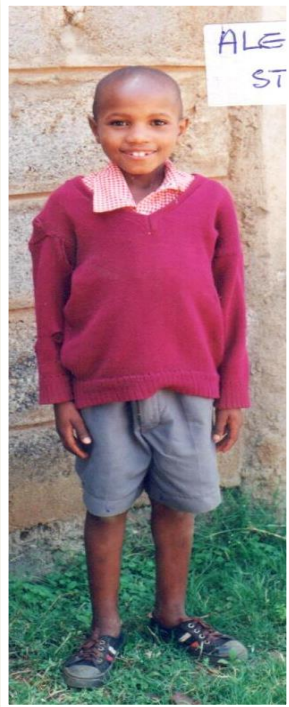

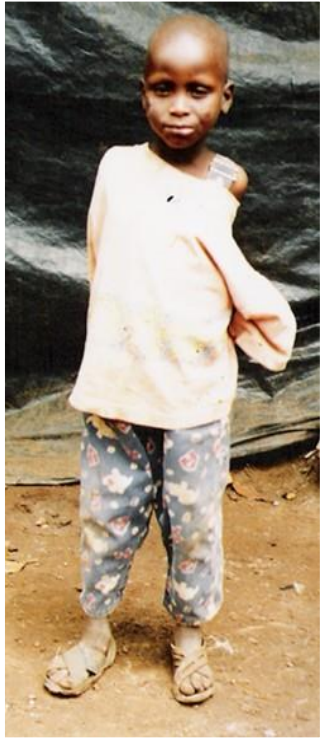

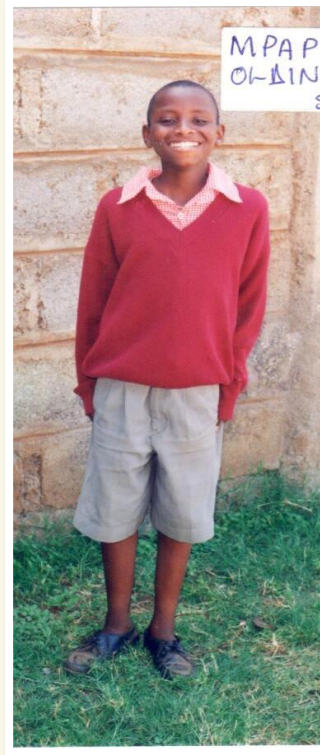

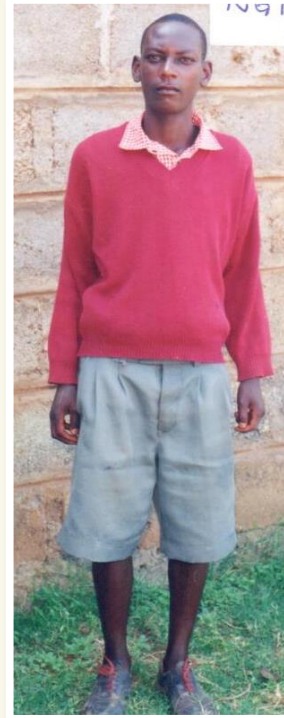

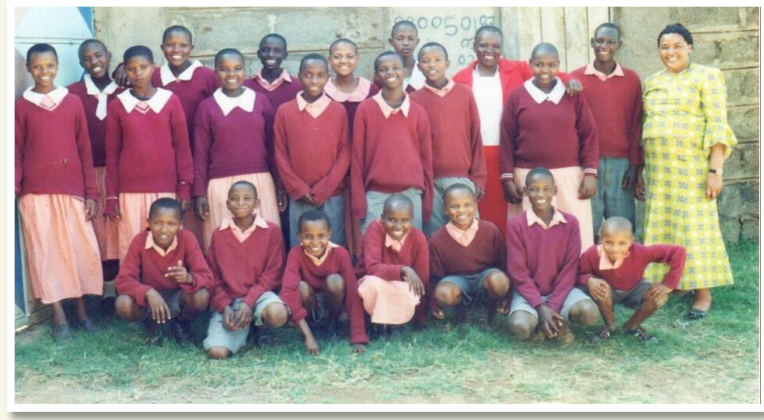
